This position, reporting to the Test Development Manager (TDM), will support New Meridian's test design and content development activities. Candidates interested in this position should have a strong working knowledge of K-12 mathematics education, large-scale summative assessment design and content development, vendor management, and customer service and relations, as well as a collaborative working style.

WHO WE ARE:

The candidate also is familiar with a variety of state test designs and has participated extensively in all phases of the content development process (e.g., planning, development and review, field-testing, and forms construction). Experience interacting with vendor, partner organization, and state education agency representatives round out the ideal candidate's resume.

EXPECTED DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES

Under the direction and leadership of the Test Development Manager, the Mathematics Content Lead provides technical expertise and deliverables in the following areas:

ASSESSEMENT CONTENT DESIGN & DEVELOPMENT

- Develops and/or reviews specification documents for content development
- Evaluates item pools and determines asset development needs for content development
- Guides vendor-produced content through all phases of the assessment development cycle
- Assists in the assembly of tests and/or pools of questions to meet specifications, and works with colleagues to ensure test forms are accessible to all students
- Assists in the recruitment, training, mentoring, and management of contracted item writers; helps develop item writer training materials, and assists with the facilitation of item writer training meetings
- Assists in planning and executing client reviews of test items, including organizing meetings, recruiting committee members, facilitating group discussions, and summarizing results
- Leads and/or supports educator meetings including content review, data review, rangefinding, and test form verification meetings
- Manages interactions and activities of an operational working group consisting of multiple vendor and state education agency representatives
- Under the guidance of the Test Development Manager, provides content-related consultation to the Business Development team in support of the New Meridian Strategic Plan

PROJECT MANAGEMENT & COMMUNICATION

- Works collaboratively with internal teams and channel partners and follows established protocols
- Is reliable, able to follow requirements in scope of work, and able to fulfill tasks accurately and on time
- Strong oral and written communication skills
